With Jetscan™ Currency Scanners:

- Mixed currency can be processed without presorting. JetScan currency scanners provide the total, individual counts and values for every bundle of mixed bills processed.
- You never have to worry about a \$20 bill being counted as a \$1 bill. While counting a single denomination, the JetScan currency scanner will stop whenever a bill of another denomination is presented.
- Special Enhanced Ultraviolet sensing system (EUV) catches many counterfeits that normal magnetic and ultraviolet sensors miss.
- Bills can be quickly "faced" so they all have the same colored side up and even "oriented" so that all of the pictures are right side up.
- Different levels of suspect detection settings can be designated for each denomination, allowing for higher screening of larger bills, without the hassle of stopping on \$1's and 5's.
